Max THC (and Max CBD) are calculated values for total cannabinoids after heating, assuming complete decarboxylation of the acid to the neutral form. It is calculated based on the weight loss of the acid group during decarboxylation: Max THC = (0.877 x THCA) + THC. This calculation does not include other cannabinoid isomers (eg. D8-THC and exo-THC). ND = None detected above the limits of detection (LOD), which is half of LOQ.
